The project aims to focus its activities on the following three areas of the call:

1. Children as victims and perpetrators of violence.
2. Perpetrator programmes and intervention
3. Empowerment work at grass-roots level

Objectives	<p>The project aims to develop strategies for primary and secondary prevention to supplement the care currently provided to women victims, their sons and daughters and aggressors from the Municipal Service Attention to Gender Violence and specifically:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Develop procedures for intervention and evaluation indicators of the Psycho-educational Care Programme to children of victims of gender violence.2. Primary and secondary prevention of gender violence among males, especially those related to the identification of gender stereotypes, identification and regulation of emotions, and training for finding a positive model of masculinity.3. Empower women (including victims of domestic violence) based on its diversity.4. Helping young people to identify behaviours that generate sexist violence, in order to prevent them.5. Promote among the public and specific groups, the responsibility in the detection and reporting of domestic violence situations.
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Activities	<p>To ensure the impact and effectiveness of the activities we propose a methodology of networking with the implication of different actors in every phase of the process: assessment, design of strategies and activities and evaluation of results.</p> <p>The project includes the following activities:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Conducting focus groups to identify key challenges and gaps in current services and development strategies and their evaluation. Different groups should be developed: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - professionals who refer users to the care centers - schools staff - young people in schools - users who have completed treatment - victims of domestic violence - sensitized men 2. Activity design 3. Dissemination 4. Implementation of activities and their management through different devices and municipal programs. 5. Evaluation of results and impact 6. Dissemination of results, exchange of good practices
